Dr. Zubair Ashraf provided an in-depth analysis of the article, discussing AI's potential role in medical diagnostics and its limitations. He emphasized that while AI demonstrates impressive analytical capabilities, practical examination remains superior to AI-based evaluations. Through various examples, he illustrated how clinical skills, real-time patient assessment, and hands-on experience play a crucial role in accurate diagnosis and treatment—something AI currently lacks.

Additionally, he highlighted that AI should be viewed as an assistant rather than a replacement for doctors. A trained medical professional can leverage AI to aid in diagnosing critical cases, but final decisions must

always be made by experienced physicians. The discussion underscored that AI can enhance efficiency in healthcare, but human expertise, patient interaction, and ethical judgment remain paramount.
